The Muses are off on another exciting adventure! Right now we are in California. We then moved up the coast to the Wisteria Ways House Concert Series in Oakland California on March 9th. A beautiful 1930s house with a huge back yard and (lo and behold) a wisteria vine just coming into bloom. A wonderful audience joined us and our hostess Anne Emerick there. We had folks from all over the area join us, including some of Lindsay's family. Tomorrow we head back into San Francisco for a show at the Parkside Library, then Thursday we're off to Vacaville for our last California show.

Friday we have a very long drive up to Washington where we begin our Northwest part of this tour. We'll be in that region through March 27th, both the Seattle and Portland areas and that will include performing for the Seattle Irish Week again at Seattle Center on St. Patrick's Day at noon!

Then we are off to Hawaii for the Hawaii Scottish Games, www.scotshawaii.org, our tour of the islands courtesy of the Hawaii Library System as well as our first performance on March 28th at the Tower. "An Irish Night to Kick Up Your Heels". This 3 band concert featuring Switchback with The Muses and The Doolin Rakes is being put together by our good friend Bill Comerford, owner of O'Toole's Kelley O'Neill's and the Irish Rose Pubs in Honolulu and Waikiki. It is sponsored by the Friends of St. Patrick and is their fundraiser to cover the costs of the St. Patrick's Day Parade a few weeks earlier.
